color

Before. Model has Level 8 virgin hair.

- 1. Section the hair as shown.
- 2. Apply Formula A to root area.
- 3. Apply Formula B to the back section.
- 4. Alternate Formulas C, D, E and F through the side section as shown.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 in the remaining sections.
- 6. Process, rinse and gloss the hair with Formula H.

cut

- 1. Section damp hair as shown.
- 2. Crop the back section, cutting from short to long as shown, creating the outline.
- Section off a crown section as shown.
 Create two subsections at the crown and cut using a twist-and-slice-cut technique.
- 4. Using the previous point as a guide, create pivoting, %-inch sections, extending to the front hairline. Twist-and-slice-cut each one.
- Comb the hair. Define a point in the crown area and cut from short to long. Continue in this manner, pivoting off of the original section.
- 6. Create the outline as shown.

styling

- Apply Wella Professionals Velvet
 Amplifier and Wella Professionals
 Natural Volume Styling Mousse to damp hair. Distribute evenly from roots to ends and dry the hair.
- 2. Using a conical styler, curl sections that pivot off of the crown.
- 3. Finalize the shape and mist with **Wella Professional Stay Essential**.
