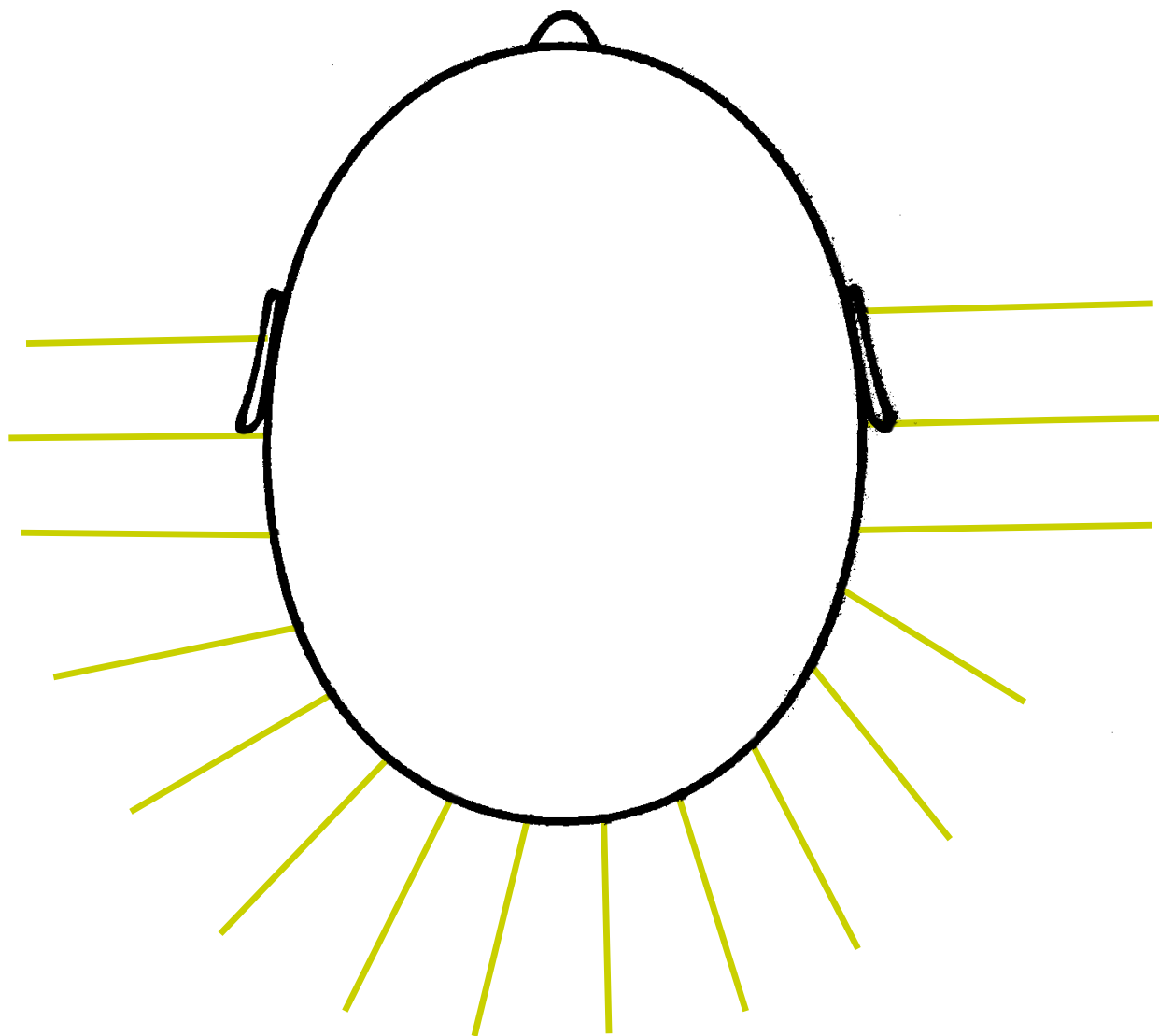

1) When cutting the perimeter, always comb the hair into its natural fall.

Overdirecting the perimeter sections will negatively affect the shape you want to create. **REMEMBER:** Avoid overdirection, tension and elevation around the entire perimeter.

2) To create a contoured bob, shaping and texturizing the hair will be super important. When shaping, elevate the crown and sides at 45 degrees, allowing the perimeter to fall out.

3) Point cut the crown and sides while holding 45-degree elevation. This creates needed space for movement while removing weight.

4) Continue to elevate around the head until you reach the final top sections. Using this technique ensures that the shape will remain soft without any bulk.

PRO TIP: Chris says, 'Just pretend like you're doing half of a rounded layer haircut!'

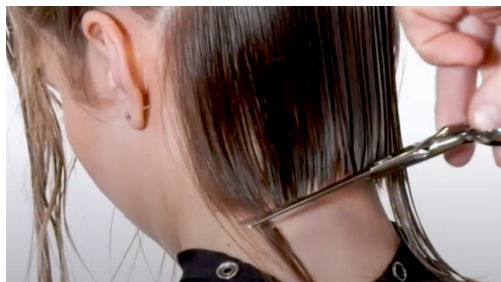
