Contour Layered Cut

- 1) Section from the occipital bone up and move all hair underneath out of the way. Let top section down to begin layering.
- 2) Using your client's desired part as a guide, slightly elevate the front section and bring it forward across your client's face until it reaches their nose. Using the tip of their nose as your starting point, layer this section to the desired length. Repeat on the other side through each top section.
- 3) Dropping the bottom section down, continue to bring each section forward and cut to length. This technique will create a soft U-Shape throughout the entire head.
- 4) Bring all hair to the back to check your shaping and clean up any areas.

PRO TIP: Drea says, 'This is a modern take on soft, round layers. Use slide and point cutting techniques throughout the haircut to create an elongated, soft look."


